Caring for someone with dementia

Part three

OU ou may not think of yourself as a carer, particularly if the person with dementia is a partner, parent or close friend.

However, both the carer and the person with dementia will need support to cope with the symptoms and changes in behaviour.

Following on from last month's feature, here are more ways to help those affected.

Sleep problems

Dementia can affect people's sleep patterns and cause problems with a person's "body clock".

People with dementia may get up repeatedly during the night and be disorientated when they do so. They may try to get dressed as they're not aware it's night-time.

How you can help

Sleep disturbance may be a stage of dementia that will settle over time.

In the meantime, try these tips:

- put a dementia-friendly clock by the bed that shows whether it's night or day
- · make sure the person has plenty of daylight and physical activity during the day
- · cut out caffeine and alcohol in the evenings
- · make sure the bedroom is comfortable and either have a night light or blackout blinds
- · limit daytime naps if possible

your GP or community nurse for advice.

Looking after yourself

Caring for a partner, relative or close friend with dementia is demanding and can be stressful.

It's important to remember that your needs as a carer are as important as the person you're caring for. Find out about looking after yourself when you care for someone with dementia on the Dementia UK website.

What is a mortgage?

Types, how they work and examples



WHAT is a mortgage?
A mortgage is a loan
used to purchase or maintain
a home, plot of land, or other
real estate.

The borrower agrees to pay the lender over time, typically in a series of regular payments divided into principal and interest.
The property then serves as collateral to secure the loan.

A borrower must apply for a mortgage through their preferred lender and meet several requirements, including minimum credit scores and down payments. Mortgage applications undergo a rigorous underwriting process before they reach the. Mortgage types, such as conventional or fixed-rate loans, vary based on the borrower's needs.

How mortgages work

Individuals and businesses use mortgages to buy real estate without paying the entire purchase price upfront. The borrower repays the loan plus interest over a specified number of years until they own the property free and clear. Most traditional mortgages are fully amortized.

This means that the regular payment amount will stay the same, but different proportions of principal vs. interest will be paid over the life of the loan with each payment. Typical mortgage terms are for 15 or 30 years, but some mortgages can run for longer terms.

Mortgages are also known as

liens against property or claims on property. If the borrower stops paying the mortgage, the lender can repossess the property.

For example, a residential homebuyer pledges their house to their lender, which then has a claim on the property. This ensures the lender's interest in the property should the buyer default on their financial obligation. In the case of repossession, the lender may evict the residents, sell the property, and use the money from the sale to

pay off the mortgage debt. The mortgage process

Would-be borrowers begin the process by applying to one or more mortgage lenders. The lender will ask for evidence that the borrower can repay the loan. This may include

bank and investment statements, recent tax returns, and proof of current employment. The lender will generally run a credit check as well. If the application is approved, the lender will offer the borrower a loan up to a certain amount and at a particular interest rate. Thanks

to a process known as preapproval, homebuyers can apply for a mortgage after they have chosen a property to buy or even while they are still shopping for one. Being pre-approved for a mortgage can give buyers an edge in a tight housing market because sellers will know that they have the money to back up their offer.

Once a buyer and seller agree on the terms of their deal, they or their representatives will meet at what's called a closing. This is when the borrower makes their down payment to the lender. The seller will transfer ownership of the property to the buyer and receive the agreed-upon sum of money, and the buyer will sign any remaining mortgage documents. The lender may charge fees for originating the loan (sometimes in the form of points) at the closing.

Options

There are hundreds of options.. You can get a mortgage through a credit union, bank, mortgage-specific lender, online-only lender, or mortgage broker. No matter which option you choose, compare rates across types to make sure that you're getting the best deal.

Korean chilli, sesame and honey chicken



Ingredients

- 12 chicken thighs, boneless and skinless
- 2 tbsp soy sauce
- 1 tbsp sesame oil
- thumb-sized piece ginger, grated
- 4 spring onions, sliced

For the glaze

- 4 tbsp Korean chilli paste (gochujang) or use a mixture of 3 tbsp ketchup and 1 tbsp sriracha chilli sauce
- 2 tbsp honey
- juice 1/2 lime
- 1 tbsp soy sauce
- 1 tsp sesame oil
- 2 tbsp sesame seeds

Method

1 Toss the chicken in the soy sauce, sesame oil and ginger. Thread each thigh on two long metal skewers, so that each skewer pierces one side of the thigh. Keep threading the chicken, making sure it's packed onto the skewers tightly. Chill until you're ready to cook. Mix the ingredients for the glaze.

- 2 Heat the BBQ. If using a coal BBQ, wait for the coals to turn ashen before you start cooking. Cook the kebab for 5-8 mins on each side (depending on the heat). Once nicely charred but not fully cooked through, start painting on the glaze. The honey will catch if cooked for too long the key to nice sticky chicken is applying the glaze in lavers, turning the kebab often.
- 3 For the watercress mayonnaise, blitz the watercress with the lemon juice until finely chopped, then stir through the mayonnaise. Blanch the asparagus for 4 mins, then drain under cold water. This can all be done a day in advance.
- 4 Once the glaze has been used up and the chicken is cooked through (it'll take about 20 mins in total), transfer to a plate and leave to cool for 5 mins before serving scattered with spring onions.

...in 1950 England lose to USA

On 29 June 1950, the United States defeated England 1-0 in a World Cup group match at Estádio Independência in Belo Horizonte, Minas Gerais, Brazil. The game's only goal was scored by Haitian-born U.S. centre forward Joe Gaetiens. The match is widely considered as one of the greatest upsets in football history.

The 1950 FIFA World Cup was England's World Cup debut, the Football Association having boycotted the previous three tournaments and, at the time, England had a reputation as the 'Kings of Football', with a post-war

record of 23 wins, four defeats and three draws. The American team consisted of semi-professional players, most of whom had other jobs to support their families. Newspaper headlines in most World Cup nations trumpeted the shocking upset, except ironically in the United States and England. At home, newspapers had only a few pages devoted to sport, and because the English cricket team happened to suffer their first-ever home defeat to the West Indies on the same day, that was the major story in many publications. The team's performance was nonetheless heavily criticised, with headlines such as "England Caned At Football Too".

...in 1815 Battle of Waterloo

The Battle of Waterloo was fought on Sunday 18 June 1815, near Waterloo (at that time part of the Netherlands, now in Belgium), marking the

end of the Napoleonic Wars. The French Imperial Army under the command of Napoleon I was defeated by two armies of the Seventh Coalition. One of these was a Britishled force with units from the United Kingdom, the Netherlands, Hanover, Brunswick and Nassau. under the command of field marshal Arthur Wellesley, Duke of Wellington. The other comprised three corps of the

Prussian army under Field Marshall

Blücher.

Waterloo cost Wellington around 17,000 dead or wounded, and Blücher some 7,000 (810 of which were suffered by just one unit: the 18th Regiment). Napoleon's losses

were 24,000 to 26,000 killed or wounded. including 6,000 to 7,000 captured with

an additional 15,000 deserting subsequent to the battle and over the following days.

Major W. E. Frye visited the battlefield in the aftermath: "...on arrival there the sight was too horrible to behold. I felt sick in the stomach and was obliged to return. The multitude of carcasses. the heaps of wounded men

with mangled limbs unable to move, and perishing from not having

their wounds dressed or from hunger."

The iPad Pro, iMac and MacBook Pro have already had the M4 treatment, so it's time for Apple's everyday laptop to get the firm's latest top-end hardware. New chip aside, this year's Air is very similar to the M2 version from 2022, which was the first to introduce the squared-off design to match the MacBook Pro.

Unlike the Pro, the Air is only available with the 'basic' M4 processor: there's no M4 Pro or M4 Max option. The only variable in processing terms is that the very cheapest version (13in with 256GB storage) has 8-core graphics rather than 10-core.

The rest of the specs are the same between the different default versions. it's available in 13in and 15in variants, with four colours: sky blue, starlight, midnight and the classic Mac choice of silver.







HOW TO FIX A LEAKY GUTTER

What you'll need to get your gutters working properly again

EAKY gutters aren't a problem that anyone wants to deal with but, sadly, they're not going to mend themselves.

The good news is that you can learn how to fix a leaky gutter and get it working properly again in just six simple steps.

What you'll need

- Gutter cleaning tool (£21.99 from Amazon)
- Watering can or bucket (£11.49 from Amazon)
- Replacement seal (bag of 10 for £7.84)
- Gutter sealant (Hernway All-in-One Hybrid Sealant, £12.95 from Amazon)
- Flash tape for larger holes (Bostik Flashband Self-Adhesive Flashing Tape)
- Screwdriver (6-Piece Magnetic Screwdriver Set from Amazon)

Identify the source

Some of the most common leak points include the joints between sections, any splits or cracks in the guttering, and blockages. In order to know how to fix a leaky gutter, you'll first need to identify the source of the leak.

If you have metal guttering, then check for potential rust holes. It's easiest to spot leaks during or just after heavy rain.



Clean the gutter

Focus in particular on the area where the leak is coming from, removing any debris using a gutter cleaning tool. Rinse away any leftover debris, then wait for the area to dry.

Fix any joints

Take the joint apart and inspect the seal. If it's cracked or damaged, it will need replacing. Make sure the gutter sits within the expansion marks on the fitting - this is a common issue with plastic gutters, as these joints usually snap together with a rubber

seal inside.

Seal any cracks or holes

Any cracks or holes in the gutters will need sealing if you want to stop water leaking through. Apply a generous amount of sealant, smoothing it out for good coverage. Allow it to cure as per the instructions, usually for 24-48 hours.

Patch up any larger holes

Before applying sealant, we recommend using a metal repair patch or suitable flash tape. Cut a patch larger than the hole, then apply your gutter sealant around the hole. Press the patch into place and seal around the edges.

Check the brackets and sloping

The sloping (which is just the downward angle or slant of the gutters) is secured in place via brackets, so check that these are secure. The slope should be around 1cm for every three metres of guttering, sloping gently towards the downpipe. To adjust the gutter slope, you'll need to reposition the brackets. Carefully loosen the fasteners holding the brackets in place with a screwdriver, then raise or lower the gutter to the desired level.

How to avoid an





HILE the vast majority of mechanics aren't in the habit of ripping us off, a few bad apples have made many drivers distrustful.

The world of car mechanics can seem very alien to the everyday driver, so it's crucial to be prepared and make sure you aren't taken advantage of.

Our essential car maintenance tips will identify the most common underhand tactics used by some garages and help advise you how to avoid them.

Finding 'extra faults' during an MOT

Your car seems to be running fine, but then you take it to the garage for the test and discover it won't pass without a long list of repairs.

These may genuinely be needed for your car to be legally declared roadworthy, but some garages will chance their luck in claiming 'extra' repairs are required to pass the test when they're not.

How to avoid: get recommendations from people you know

Ask family, friends and work colleagues for referrals - the best way to protect yourself against getting ripped off is to find a garage you can trust.

If you've just moved to a new area, check the RAC's network of approved garages simply by entering your location.

Overcharging for parts or labour

Garages charge a markup on parts. They buy them wholesale then sell them to you for a profit – that's how business works.

The problem is that not many people know how much parts should cost. Some mechanics try to capitalise on this by overcharging customers for components. And if a mechanic takes four hours to do a two-hour job, they'll charge you for that.

How to avoid: check the price of new parts

If the cost of a replacement part seems excessively high, call the dealer or check online to make sure it's reasonable.

A garage is well within its rights to charge you more for a part than you can buy off the internet, but if they overcharge you for parts and labour, then it might be a good idea to look somewhere else.

Get the garage to give you a quote for the planned work so you know what kind of costs you're looking at in advance. Check that it includes all parts, labour and VAT.

Blinding you with science

Unless you've got a specialised degree, you probably don't understand the finer workings of modern cars. Garage workers will sometimes deliberately bombard you with technical words and phrases if they





think your mechanical knowledge is limited.

By bamboozling you with jargon, they might convince you that extra work needs doing when it doesn't.

How to avoid: ask questions

Don't be afraid to seek clarification about anything you don't understand. If the garage can't explain in simple terms why the work needs doing, take your car elsewhere, as long as it's not dangerous to drive.

It's also worth brushing up on basic mechanics so you do at least have



a rough idea of what they're talking about.

It's much harder for a dodgy mechanic to rip off customers who know their way around a car. If you don't know your dipstick from your coolant, they'll see you coming a mile off.

Charging for parts that haven't been replaced

Unless you look inside the engine or underneath the car yourself, it's impossible to tell if parts have been replaced with brand new components. Some dishonest mechanics will put used parts in your car or charge for replacements they never actually put in.

How to avoid: ask to see replaced parts

Most garages will be happy to put the replaced parts in your boot to show what's been done and what the problem with the faulty component was.

If the garage isn't willing to do this, they probably haven't done the work properly – or even at all.

Low quote, high bill

A classic rogue trader trick is to give you a low quote verbally and then hit you with a huge bill after doing the work.

The mechanic will claim they didn't know that they would have to get the parts from the manufacturer's main dealer rather than a third-party shop.

How to avoid: get a written quote

Ask for the quote in writing, making sure it includes all the parts, labour and VAT.

A good mechanic will always get your permission before repairing anything major, so if they do need to go to the main dealer they should tell you first. Get a second opinion if necessary. Make sure the work you get done is guaranteed for at least 12 months and keep the receipt.





Everything you need to know about planning and installing a room in the garden.

A DDING a room to the garden can be an ideal solution for some extra living space, but how do you actually create a garden room and how can you make sure it works for your lifestyle?

If you have space in your garden, then embracing garden room ideas can be a cost-effective alternative to adding an extension.

But you'll need to carefully consider how to best utilise the space so that it feels like an extension of your home, even if it's not physically connected to it.

What is a garden room?

If you're not sure on the difference between a conservatory and a garden room, you're not alone. Garden rooms are usually standalone structures with a solid roof that can be positioned to provide great views of the garden while acting as an additional space for activities that don't fit in your existing home. This could be anything from a home office or hobby space to a home gym.

More people now choose a garden room rather than a conservatory, since their solid roof construction makes them highly suitable for year-round living.

The simplest cabin or summer house is similar to a shed, with either shiplap walls and cedar roof shingles or a log-cabin construction. These are usually supplied in pre-fabricated

panels and, if you're a skilled DIYer, you could put one up yourself. More advanced garden room designs, with sliding glass doors or a deck, for example, will need to be built on site by a specialist. Once the concrete base or piles are in, installation can take from one day to two weeks.

What are garden rooms made from?

High-quality garden rooms are typically built using a layered composite wall system that balances durability with energy efficiency. The outer cladding often features weatherboard and timber battens, which not only create a classic look but also offer strong protection

against the elements.
Internally, it's common to find rockwool or similar insulation materials within the wall cavity. These provide excellent thermal and acoustic performance, making the space suitable for year-round use. The interior walls are usually finished with plasterboard and a skim coat, giving a smooth, professional surface

that can be decorated just like

any other room in the home. In terms of glazing, aluminium-framed, double-glazed doors and windows are a popular standard, not just for insulation, but also for enhancing security and soundproofing.
